Ordinary Business

- After a pot-luck supper, Kerry Daly called the meeting to order at 6:55 pm.

- The April 11 meeting minutes were approved as corrected.

Worship Commission Membership

- Members thanked Hilary Paskowitz for her service to the Commission.
- Several potential candidates for committee membership were identified.
- Kevin Boden volunteered to make the inquiry to ascertain whether they are willing to serve.

New Business

- Don Crean announced that his new full time position at USF would require him to phase out of his current half time position as Liturgy Director for the Parish. After the committee came out of shock, Don explained he will remain active throughout the summer and will fade out slowly from his current Parish liturgical responsibilities. He assured all that he is not leaving, and will remain an active member of the Parish community.
- Stephen St. Marie will be in touch with Fr. Blaettler to liaison with the Worship Commission.
- Other issues which need supervision and leadership include scheduling of the liturgical ministers, Lector training, training of Eucharistic Ministers, and training of Alter Servers.
- Team leaders need to be developed for each service in order to “MC” or choreograph the service.
- Parish Picnic is being actively planned by a committee headed by Fran Van Bergen.
- Music is considered to be one of the biggest issues facing the Worship Commission. The suggestion of a Music Advisory Committee was discussed without resolution.
